



## January 27, 2007 POND HOCKEY TOURNAMENT

---

### **RULES**

1. Roster
  - a. Minimum of 2 Arbour Lake Residents must be on the roster
  - b. Minimum of 2 players on the roster must be over 12 years of age.
  - c. Minimum of 4 players and a maximum of 6 players on the roster.
  - d. No roster changes permitted once registration is confirmed.
2. Teams must be present and ready to play 5 minutes before game time. Defaults will be charged to any team 5 minutes late for the game start time.
3. Teams must have a minimum of 3 players on the ice to start a game. If this minimum is not met the offending team will receive a default.
4. Helmets, skates and gloves/hockey gloves are mandatory. Other protective equipment is optional but recommended.

**There will be an off ice official keeping score and monitoring game play, ensuring rules are being adhered to.**

### **GAME PLAY RULES**

5. Games are 25 minutes long.
6. Subs will rotate in as necessary on the fly.
7. No goaltending or goaltending sticks. Goaltending by lying down in front of the net or laying your stick down on the ice will result in a goal if the official determines a goal would have resulted if there was no obstruction.
8. Goals can only be scored from the attacking side of center ice.
9. When a goal is scored the team must give the opposing team ½ ice.
10. No off sides or icing calls.

**PENALTIES** will be called on the honor system. (The off ice official will ensure this is being adhered to.)

11. No slapshots.
12. No checking.
13. No raising the puck – such action will result in a loss of possession.
14. No high sticking – contacting the puck above the waist will result in a loss of possession or a minor penalty if deemed by the off ice official.

**\*All minor penalties result in a goal** being awarded to the other team.

**\*\*A major penalty** which includes any actions that act to harm another player will result in an **ejection from the tournament** of that player. The penalized team will then play the rest of the tournament short handed even if they have subs available.

**STANDINGS** will be determined based on games won. In the event of a tie, a winner will be decided first by the amount of goals for and then the amount of goals against. If there is still a tie, a best of 5 paper/rock/scissors will determine the winner.

**REGISTRATION** must be complete in order to be valid. Drop off registrations to the Lake Office or fax them to (403) 547-8770.
